Class 5 Topic Web Autumn Term 2 Miss Herbert

English

Writing - Our writing focus this term will be poetry and non-chronological reports. We will start the term exploring 'In Flanders Fields' poem. We will learn about rhyming but also about the importance of emotive vocabulary as a writer to make an impact on the reader. After this, we will be learning about non-chronological reports. We will look at how they are set out, the language used and third person narrative to include factual information. In grammar we will be learning about modal verbs, adverbs for degrees of possibility and looking at cohesion between paragraphs.

Mathematics

This Autumn term will start by continuing our learning of statistics. We will be looking at the different ways data can be represented. We will learn about comparing data using line graphs. After this, the children will be looking at written methods for addition and subtraction before moving onto multiplication and division. We will learn about multiplying and dividing by powers of 10, grid method and long multiplication. We will also look at bus stop method and chunking for division.

Computing

We are Bloggers is our second computing unit. Blogging provides a worldwide audience for pupils' work. We will create a media-rich blog, comment on blogs and respond to those comments.

Topic

For this part of the Autumn Term, Geography will be the biggest focus in our topic learning. We will use maps to look at what countries make up Europe and their capital cities. We will then look at physical and human features of Ancient Greece compared to modern day Greece. In DT, we will be exploring where foods come from and their global carbon footprint. We will taste and compare Greek foods during our topic day to create Greek salads.

We will start the term with looking at Incarnation. What does this mean and where can we find this in the Bible. We will explore stories of Jesus as the Messiah and his importance during the Christian festival of Christmas.
