Put story events into chronological order.
Write sentences with greater confidence and independence.

Use finger spaces in writing.

Continue to learn more tricky words.

Spell words with greater accuracy.

Recall all digraphs/trigraphs taught.

Read longer words (words of more than one syllable).

Begin to read with greater fluency, blending words in their heads.

Home learning idea: Share a favourite story book with your child. Ask them to retell what happened. Support them to put the events in the correct order.

PSED

Understand the need to exercise to keep their body healthy.

Know which foods are healthy and not so healthy.

Know how to help themselves go to sleep and understand why sleep is good for them.

Wash their hands thoroughly and understand why this is important.

Know what a stranger is and how to stay safe if a stranger approaches them.

Home learning idea: Take a photo of your child exercising and upload onto the ILD.

Topic

Plant and look after seeds.

Label the parts of a plant.

Name and describe a variety of minibeasts.

Research facts about different minibeasts.

Make a fact sheet about a minibeast.

Home learning idea: Go on a Welly Walk. What different plants and wildlife can you find? Ask your children to photograph or draw pictures of the things they see.

Home learning idea: talk about why it is important to have rules and laws.

Understand that Easter is very important in the 'Big Story' of the Bible.

Know some of the events from the Easter story.

Understand that Christians believe that Jesus is willing to forgive all.

Know how the local church celebrates Easter.

Home learning idea: Draw or paint an Easter picture and upload onto the ILD.
