

English (including phonics)

Continue to learn more digraphs and trigraphs and use these to read and write words.

Begin to write phrases and sentences, leaving finger spaces between words. Know the structure of stories (beginning, middle and end).

Talk about the key events in stories. Orally tell their own stories.

Home learning idea: Ask your child to help you write shopping lists, encouraging them to use their phonics to write words which match their sound knowledge.

Topic

Learn about people in the community who help us. Make a warm bed for Dot, the hospital dog. Investigate which materials would be the best to use.

Consider who are the real-life heroes in our community and why.

Home learning idea: Develop drawings of people and pets to include more detail.

Maths

Investigate the composition of numbers between 5 and 7.

Subitising within 5.

Use the language of comparison; 'more than, fewer than and equal to' to compare sets of objects.

Home learning idea: Play a number based board game together. Can your child use their 'fast eyes' to subitise the number on a dice?
