

### English (including phonics)

Continue to learn more digraphs and trigraphs and use these to read and write words.

Begin to write phrases and sentences, leaving finger spaces between words.

Know the structure of stories (beginning, middle and end).

Talk about the key events in stories.

Orally tell their own stories.

*Home learning idea: Ask your child to help you write shopping lists, encouraging them to use their phonics to write words which match their sound knowledge.*

### PSED

Stay motivated when doing something challenging.

Keep trying even when it is difficult.

Work well with a partner or in a group.

Have a positive attitude to learning.

Help others to achieve their goals

Are working hard to achieve their own dreams and goals.

*Home learning idea: Learn to recite their name, age and address.*

### Topic

Learn about people in the community who help us.

Make a warm coat for Dot, the hospital dog.

Investigate which materials would be the best to use.

Consider who are the real-life heroes in our community and why.

*Home learning idea: Develop drawings of people and pets to include more detail.*
