## English (including phonics)

Read and write words with consonant blends and long vowel digraphs, e.g. train, growl, spoilt.

Use known sounds to write sentences, leaving spaces between words and using capital letters and full stops.

Make a poster, reminding others to turn off the lights.

Write a newspaper report/headline about the whale who cleaned up the ocean (A Whale's Tale)

Continue to read a range of books, using phonic knowledge and tricky word recognition.

Home learning idea: Make a poster to remind your family to recycle.

### **PSED**

Changing Me

Understand that everyone is unique and special.

Express how they feel when change happens.
Understand and respect the changes that
they see in themselves.

Understand and respect the changes that they see in other people.

Know who to ask for help if they are worried about change.

Home learning idea: Look at pictures of your family from when they were little. Discuss how they have changed and compare to child's life now.

Draw maps from stories they have read.

Use maps and globes to locate countries the children have visited.
