

### English

Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.  
Represent own ideas, thoughts & feelings through role play & stories.  
Sequence pictures to retell a story.  
Say, read and begin to write the phonemes / graphemes, e.g. /s/.  
Begin to segment and blend.  
Practice blending and reading high frequency words.

*Home learning idea: Video your child retelling a favourite story.*

### Topic

Know that people have similarities and differences.  
Talk about what makes themselves special.  
Talk about the people in their family and understand that families are all different.

*Home learning idea: Ask your child to make a scrap book/memory box containing all things that are special to them.*

### Maths

Matching and sorting.  
Comparing size, mass and capacity.  
Comparing amounts.  
Exploring patterns.  
Subitising (looking at small sets of objects and instantly knowing how many are there without counting)  
Representing 1, 2 & 3.

*Home learning idea: Give your child some socks and ask them to pair them up.*

### PSED

Understand how it feels to belong and that we are similar and different.  
Start to recognise and manage their feelings.  
Enjoy working with others to make school a good place to be.

Learning what being responsible means.

*Home learning idea: Write a 'Wow' moment for your child and send it to school.*

### Physical Development

Move safely in a space.

*Home learning idea: Challenge your child to independently get dressed and undressed.*

### Value - Thankfulness

*Home learning idea: What is your child thankful for? Ask them to draw a picture or take a photo of this item.*

Retell the Creation Story.  
Know why Christians celebrate Harvest.  
Know that God's name is precious to Christians.

*Home learning idea: Ask your child to paint a picture of one of God's creations and label it.*
