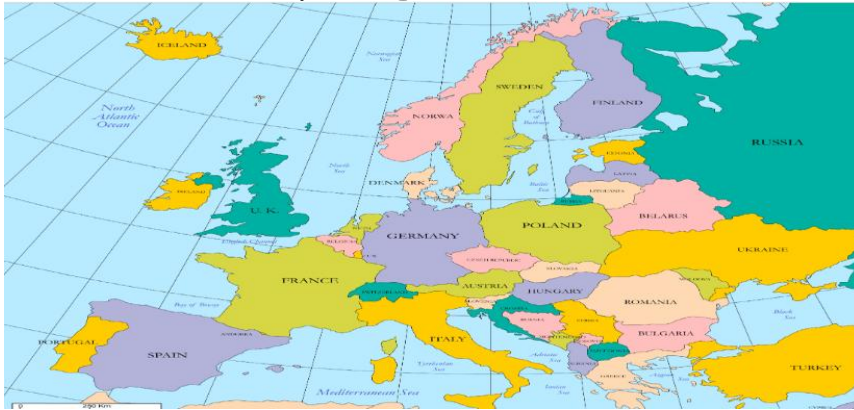




# Believe ~ Learn ~ Grow
