

Dear Class 6 Parents/Carers,

I hope you all had an enjoyable break. This term is an important one in the run up to SATs, as we continue to Believe, Learn and Grow together in 2025.

Home Learning:

Children in Oak are encouraged to read regularly for pleasure, and from a levelled reading book from our reading scheme, or a free reading book. Children will have a Big Cat book each week to read to improve reading fluency as well as a 'reading for pleasure' book of their choice. Whole Class Reading sessions take place daily, focusing on developing a range of reading skills, including retrieval, inference and explanations skills to encourage progress.

Your child has also received a revision book for Maths and English, which they are expected to use to recall and recap their learning from across KS2.

The spelling home learning will continue to go home on a Monday, with support given in school to help learn these. Spellings will continue to be a big focus. We will investigate spelling rules and patterns throughout the week. Children will be given differentiated spellings for the week, depending on the level they are working at in class. Most children will be given around 10 spellings but others might have less. Spellings will be taught during the week, followed by a test on Friday.

We will continue to focus on improving our knowledge and speed of times tables using deliberate practice on paper in class. Each term we will have a focus on times tables learning but the expectation is that children will need to know all of these now, with quick recall and application. If you would like support at home with times tables then please let us know.

PE:

PE will be taught on Monday. Children are allowed to wear their PE kits in school for the entire day on their PE days.

Forest Schools

Forest School will take place on a Tuesday afternoon with Mrs dos Santos. Please ensure your child brings suitable clothing and footwear.
