Our Year 6 pupils will soon be undertaking their Key Stage 2 (KS2) Standard Assessment Tests, often referred to as SATs. These assessments are a snapshot of the child's learning in English (reading, grammar, punctuation, and spelling) and mathematics by the end of Key Stage 2. These national tests help us, as a school, to understand how well our pupils are progressing against national standards and identify areas where we can continue to provide support and enrichment. The results also contribute to a broader national picture of educational attainment.

It's important to remember that SATs are just one part of our comprehensive assessment process. Throughout the year, teachers continuously assess children's understanding and progress through various activities and observations. The SATs results are considered alongside this ongoing teacher assessment to provide a well-rounded view of children's achievements.
