Don't ignore the signs

Meningitis and septicaemia

Severe headache **Dislike of bright light**

Stiff neck **Confusion and/or irritability**

Rapid breathing **Vomiting/diarrhoea**

Seizures/fits **Stomach cramps**

High temperature **Rash/bruising rash**

Drowsy or difficult to wake **Pale blotchy skin**

Cold hands and feet **Joint or muscle pain**

Meningitis can kill in hours
