Mr Farmer's message

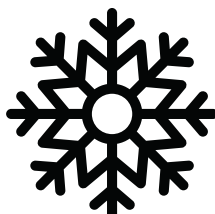
Dear families,

I am pleased to announce the introduction of our new Parent Forum, an initiative designed to enhance communication and collaboration within our school community.

This forum will consist of one parent representative from each class, along with an additional representative for SEND matters.

The primary purpose of the Parent Forum is to serve as a sounding board for various school-related decisions. Topics for discussion might include the format of school photographs, potential changes to school uniforms, and the structure of our sports day events. While the forum's input is invaluable, it's important to note that its role is advisory rather than decisive.

The plan is for the forum to meet once a term for no more than an hour.

This platform will also provide an opportunity for us to explain the rationale behind certain school practises and to address agenda items raised by the parent community. To maintain focus and confidentiality, discussions will not involve individual pupils, staff members, or parents.

In cases where multiple parents express interest, representatives will be selected through a random draw.
